### June 24-28 Critter Camp

Hands-on animal encounters with opportunities to get up close, feed and hold many different animals including a hedgehog, turtle, ferret, and guinea pigs.

### July 1-5 Frogs, Toads & Salamanders (no July 4)

Campers will be introduced to an exciting diversity of amphibians. We will learn how to identify frogs by their calls and tadpoles.

Bridges, towers, ramps, inventions! Campers will spend the week using their imagination and engineering skills to solve engineering challenges. We will also create amazing mazes for our animals.

### July 15-19 Super Science

Liquid nitrogen ice cream is back! This is a week filled with interactive experiments. Join us for astonishing experiments exploring chemistry, engineering, biology and more.

### July 22-26 Reptile Encounters

Our wildlife sanctuary is home to dozens of reptiles. This week will offer exciting reptile experiences including bathing lizards, racing turtles, and learning how to hold snakes. Meet our giant snapping turtle too!

### July 29-August 2 Animal Keepers

Go behind the scenes and help us care for animals. Activities will include preparing food, feeding and exercising animals. A veterinarian will be here to teach us about keeping animals healthy and how to care for injured animals.

### August 5-9 Marvelous Mammals

Have a blast meeting different furry animals for the week. Campers will have a chance to interact with many of our mammals including our chinchilla, guinea pigs, rabbits and ferrets.

### August 12-16 Fantastic Beasts

From dragons to unicorns, become a magizoologist and join us for a mythical week including making dragon eggs, doing magical experiments, and learning the myths behind our constellations.

### August 19-23 To the Extreme

Join us for a high energy, action packed week of end-of-the-summer fun! We will have obstacle courses, relay races, and scavenger hunts throughout the museum. \* Please note obstacle courses will be made of safe materials including hula hoops, cones and pool noodles.

#### Camp Health Requirements

- Record of physical examination from within the last **3 years**, with **immunization history**, **MUST** be submitted to us **BEFORE** the child attends the program.
- Documents must be signed by a doctor and feature an exam date from within the last **3 years**.
- A **Medication Authorization** Form is necessary for any child requiring medication administered while at camp.
- If your child requires an **Epi Pen** there is an additional form that must be filled out and have a physician's signature. While at camp, the Epi Pen (or other medication) must be in its original packaging with **prescription label attached**.
