March 30
Good Friday

Space Day - Have a blast learning about space for the day. Campers will watch a planetarium show, create their own origami solar panels, and make air-powered rockets.

April 9
April Break

Sharks and Fossils - Spend the day learning about one of the most fascinating creatures on earth – sharks! We will examine shark teeth and learn about many types of fossils. Each camper will bring home their own shark tooth.

April 10
April Break

Edible Experiments - Come join us for a day filled to bursting with experiments you can eat. We will make liquid nitrogen ice cream, experiment with candy, and learn about the science of making food.

April 11
April Break

Amphibians - Join us for a day as we meet many of our amphibians including frogs, toads, and salamanders. Campers will make amphibian slime and learn about the importance of protecting these special creatures.

April 12

Trees and Animals - Campers will spend the day learning about sugar gliders and other animals that fly and glide from tree to tree. We will learn how to identify birds and trees found around the museum.

Can you Think Ink? - Join us for a day of learning about different types of inks, including squid ink, man-made inks, invisible ink, and tattoos. Campers will create their own temporary tattoos.

Camp Health Requirements

- Record of physical examination from within the last **3 years**, with **immunization history**, **MUST** be submitted to us **BEFORE** the child attends the program.
- Documents must be signed by a doctor and feature an exam date from within the last **3 years**.
- A **Medication Authorization** Form is necessary for any child requiring medication administered while at camp.
- If your child requires an **Epi Pen** there is an additional form that must be filled out and have a physician's signature. While at camp, the Epi Pen (or other medication) must be in its original packaging with **prescription label attached**.
