Program Philosophy

The Children's Museum Preschool is a **play-based program** that encourages and develops learning through each child's natural activities. Experts agree that by learning through play, children will find education to be a positive and joyous process. Our focus on this philosophy is at the core of our curriculum.

We know that all children are different, and each one comes to us with different strengths and areas for growth. Using proven techniques and following the CT Early and Development Standards, we tailor our classes to be sensitive to the needs of each individual child while maintaining an affirming and inclusive environment for all.

Our experienced and degreed educators encourage children to explore, imagine and create which, in turn, enhances and develops each child's critical thinking skills, scientific understanding, mathematic skills, creativity and ability to express themselves. We structure our classes and activities to facilitate the growth of important social skills such as: sharing, taking turns, and respecting the rights of others.

A typical school day includes activities and experiential learning that enhance social, emotional, intellectual, and physical growth. Each week on a rotating basis, our children experience developmentally appropriate planetarium shows and science classes taught by museum educators, as well as animal demonstrations with our wildlife sanctuary staff. Children in the preschool often explore the museum with their teachers as guides. As an added bonus, Preschool Families receive a **Museum Family Membership** giving families the opportunity to visit and explore the museum together.

\$320 per week

- Tuition is paid for the upcoming week, payment due each Monday, Monthly payments due 1st Monday of the Month.
- Full-time tuition is based on a 5 day a week program, not discounted for fewer days or hours. We do not piggyback students, but save that classroom placement for your child.
- Full-time preschool can be Academic Year Sept.-June, or Full Year.
- We do not follow West Hartford Public School's Calendar. School is closed New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and the day after, Christmas Day and the day after, two development days and one med. training day.
- A Partial Scholarship may be available for Full time-full year families below 75% of the state's median income. Limited availability

Care for Kids Subsidy Program
