- Each semester will have a different topic based off of research that Sara has been involved with.
- After traveling to Belize to help with a conservation project on crocodiles, Sara will bring back her experience and knowledge to teach kids.
- We do not have live crocodiles at the museum, but students will have a hands on experience with a different animal each class.
- Each class will be different, but some activities this semester may include:
 - Experimenting with animal behavior
 - Making a take-home poster of facts about crocodiles
 - Learning about conservation
 - Proper animal handling techniques
 - Creating take home projects on animals
 - Looking at bones of animals
 - Learning about careers that involve researching animals
 - Learning how to identify different species of crocodilians
 - Practice presenting information
 - Learning about how to track animals using footprints and radio telemetry
