

Program Participant Behavior Contract

All participants are expected to:

1. Model good behavior for other participants. This includes: having respect for their teachers, fellow students, museum animals and museum property at all times so that they are not disrupting the activities planned for the day.
2. Speak at appropriate times at an appropriate volume and in a polite and kind way both towards their teachers and fellow participants.

Consequences for failing to meet these expectations:

1. Students will be gently reminded of these expectations and encouraged to follow them.
2. If an issue continues after a participant has been spoken to during a program session, or a participant is deliberately acting in a way to disrupt a program session, their parent/guardian will be notified that day and asked to pick up their child.
3. More serious issues will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis after a discussion with a participant's parents/guardians about appropriate consequences up to and including possible dismissal from the program.
